
4. Always make sure **Fence Hog®** is securely fastened to skid steer.



- 5. Stay clear of gate opening while machine is running. Keep all body parts, solid objects, clothing, and jewelry away from all moving parts.
- 6. Never perform any work on the **Fence Hog®** while it is running. Before working on the **Fence Hog®**, stop skid steer and disconnect the hydraulic hose to prevent accidental starting.



- 7. Avoid contact with hot hydraulic fluid. Allow system to cool before performing any repairs or service, such as adding fuel or oil.
- 8. Never stand under an elevated **Fence Hog®**.
- 9. Never ride the **Fence Hog®**.
- 10. Never operate the **Fence Hog®** under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or medications.
- 11. Use only factory authorized parts.





- 13. Always wear approved safety glasses and hard hats when operating or servicing a **Fence Hog®**.
- 14. Do not use the **Fence Hog®** as a lifting device and do not load more than one roll of fence fabric or wire in the **Fence Hog®** at a time.

Maintenance

Grease fittings located on the **Fence Hog®** and Extension. See drawing for location of fittings. All grease fittings should be greased before each use with EPI rated or equivalent grease.

- 1 Record the Model number and Serial Number from the Serial Number Tag located on the left rear of the **Fence Hog®**.

Opearting Instructions

Loading Wire

- 1 Attach the **Fence Hog®** to your skid steer. Consult skid steer owner's manual for attachment proceedure.
- 2 Connect hydraulic hoses to skid steer auxiliary hydraulic couplers.
- 3 Using the auxiliary hydraulics, cycle all hydrualic motions to verify the **Fence Hog®** is operating correctly. Verify that the cage opens and closes completely and moves smoothly throughout its travel of operation.

Note: If Skidsteer is equiped with variable flow hydraulics, operate on Max. Flow

- 4 Open the **Fence Hog®** to its widest point and position your skid steer so that a roll of wire is directly in front of it.
- 5 Then lift the boom and tilt the **Fence Hog®** down.
- 6 Move the skid steer forward until the turntable of the **Fence Hog®** aligns with the bottom of the roll of fence.
- 7 Lower the **Fence Hog®** over the roll of wire and begin closing the gates. Once the gates are mostly closed, lift the boom and tilt the Fence Hog® up.
- 8 The roll of wire will fall back into the cage of the **Fence Hog®**. Close the **Fence Hog®** tightly.


Note: For Woven Wire - Install Roll Centering Rod through the center of roll and into turntable to hold roll upright by removing the Roll Centering Rod from the square tube on the back of the Fence Hog® and sliding it through the center of wire roll and into the hole in the turntable. Then, install Centering Rod support over Centering Rod.

Installing Fence

- 1 After loading a roll of wire, move the skid steer parellel to the row of fence posts and attach the beginning of the roll to the first fence post.
- 2 Slowly drive the skid steer along the fence line and the roll will start to unwind. Continue to desired point.
- 3 At the stretch point, install a tension bar (supplied by customer) into the fabric at the point of discharge.
- Optional Chain Link Stretcher: At stretching point, pull Handle and rotate Stretching Bar until fingers point outward. Insert fingers through the fabric. Skip to Step 5.
- Optional Woven Wire Stretcher: Install optional woven wire stretcher to the gate ends. Using the holes provided, drive the wedges into stretcher to hold wire and stretch to desired tension.
- 4 Remove stretching pins from holder and insert through holes at the end of the gates and in front of the tension bar.
- 5 Maneuver the skid steer so the fabric is aligned with the fence line. Hold close pressure on gate and stretch to desired tension.
- 6 Attach fabric to post once desired tension is reached.
- 7 Relieve pressure on fabric and return pins to holder.
- 8 Repeat steps 1 through 7 as needed.




